

## **Boca Christian Athletics Home School Policy**

April 24, 2010

Boca Christian welcomes the participation of home school students to Boca Christian High Schools athletic teams.

The middle school policy for home school students, however, has been changed to the following and will be effective starting with the 2010-2011 school year.

1. Middle school home school students are eligible to try out for BRCS high school teams.
2. Home school middle school students may sign up for middle school football only.
3. Middle school home school students currently in the BRCS middle school athletic program will be grandfathered in and will be able to complete their remaining eligibility on all middle school teams.
4. All other Boca Christian middle school athletic teams will not be open to home school participation at this time because of Boca Christians no cut policy for BRCS middle school students, which results in too many players on the team for an effective program. (Exception: In the event a team does not have enough BRCS players to field a team, the Athletic Director has the discretion to invite home school students to participate.)
6. If a middle school home school student decides to try out and makes a high school athletic team, that student will be permitted to participate on the high school team without restriction.
7. **Home school families need to attend one of two required meetings** if they are interested in their child playing on a BRCS team for the 2010-2011 school year. The first meeting is scheduled for AUGUST 31, 2010 in the Boca Christian Media Center at 7 p.m. The second meeting is expected to be in January 2011 and will be announced on the BRCS website.
