

Bibliographic Citation Examples For HyperStudio Projects

This bibliographic citation information is specific to HyperStudio Project. A bibliography is an alphabetical list of sources used when writing a report (or in this case creating a HyperStudio Project). It is the last card of a HyperStudio Stack and sources should be grouped together (by source type). Within each source type, each source should be listed alphabetically. Indenting, spacing, commas, periods, underlining, and other punctuation are important.

For bibliographic citation information for photos or sounds used from resources on the internet, refer to the World Wide Web citation information (on back page of Bibliographic Citation Examples handed out in computer class or on Boca Christian school website.

HyperStudio Sources (sound, graphics, animation)

"Title of resource." HyperStudio 4. Version 4.2.0. Knowledge Adventure, Inc., 2000.

Citing Resources

Online Images

Author. Description or title of image. (Online image) Date of document or download. <<http://address/filename>>.

Johnson, Joe. Pyramid. (Online image) August 13, 2007. <http://loc.gov>.

If you make use of other material on the web page, cite the web page as a whole in your Works Cited list and refer to the specific image in the text.

If you are citing a photograph you took yourself:

Subject of photo. Personal photography by author. Date photo was taken.

Pelicans. Personal photograph by John Doe. August 13, 2007.

Freely available graphics and clip art do not need to be cited or referenced.

Online Sounds

Author or originator. Description of sound. (Online sound) Date of document or download <<http://address/filename>>.

Smith, Jane. Rushing wind. (Online sound) August 10, 2007.
<<http://address/filename>>.

Online Video Clips

Author or originator. Description or title of video clip. (Online video clip) Date of document or download <<http://address/filename>>.

National Geographic. Australia. (Online video clip) January 4, 2007.
<<http://address/filename>>.

E-mail

Sender of e-mail message <sender's e-mail address>. Subject line of message. Date of message. E-mail recipient <recipient's e-mail address>.
