**TUITION:** Payment via automatic debit (ACH) from your bank account is highly recommended. *You will receive a \$20.00 credit each tuition billing month while participating in this program (\$220 credit if you participate for the entire school year).* ACH authorization forms are available in the school's main office and in the business office. Note: ACH discount applies only when tuition is paid according to the school's payment schedule - May through March.

**MONTHLY PAYMENT SCHEDULE:** Tuition is divided into eleven (11) payments, payable on the first of each month beginning with May 1, 2011 and ending with March 1, 2012. (NEW FAMILIES SEE BELOW.) The first tuition payment and subsequent payments must be made on schedule to ensure space for your child(ren). A LATE FEE of \$25 is charged when payment is received after the 10th of the month. When a student voluntarily withdraws from the school for any reason, tuition is pro-rated based on the number of school days the student was enrolled and an early withdrawal fee of 2/11 of the annual tuition (the equivalent of two monthly payments) is charged. The withdrawal fee applies to all registered students withdrawn after May 10, 2011, even though classes are not scheduled to begin until August.

**PRE-PAYMENT DISCOUNT:** A tuition discount of 5% will be applied for all accounts paid in full by May 10, 2011.

**FAMILY DISCOUNT:** (Applies to tuition only; K3 and K4 tuition is not eligible). For families who enroll more than one child, tuition discounts are applied as follows: first child, no discount; second child, 5% discount; third and additional child(ren), 10% discount. The higher percentage discounts are applied to the tuition of lesser amount.

**HIGH SCHOOL LAPTOP PROGRAM:** This program includes wireless and Internet network connectivity, access to printers, software and technology support. All high school students are issued a laptop in their sophomore year. The program does not insure laptop computers against theft, loss or unusual damage; this is the responsibility of the student's family. Parents may include this risk in their home owners coverage or purchase a separate laptop policy. One company currently offers such a policy at a cost of \$250.00 for three years' coverage. Students who attend BRCHS all four years will be given their laptop at graduation.

**NEW FAMILIES ONLY:** A NON-REFUNDABLE CONFIRMATION PAYMENT in the amount of 2/11 of the annual tuition (the equivalent of two monthly payments) is due at the time of each child's acceptance to BRCS. The Confirmation Payment must be returned with the signed contract to confirm the family's intention of accepting the school's enrollment invitation.

**NEW FAMILIES ONLY (Continued):** IF CONFIRMATION PAYMENT IS NOT RECEIVED WITHIN TWO WEEKS OF THE DATE OF THE ACCEPTANCE NOTIFICATION THE CHILD(REN)'S SPACE WILL BECOME AVAILABLE TO OTHERS MAKING APPLICATION. The Confirmation Payment will be credited against the student's tuition. Withdrawal fees, as discussed under TUITION, apply to all students.

**FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:** If you need assistance, applications for financial aid are available in the office after January 1, 2011. Returning students should apply for financial assistance *no later than March 1, 2011.* You are responsible for payment of FULL TUITION prior to receiving a financial aid award.

**REGISTRATION FEE - APPLIES TO NEW FAMILIES ONLY:** \$195 per student. (Does not apply to K4 - 3 Hours with VPK Certificate.) The registration fee must accompany the registration forms. This fee is NOT REFUNDABLE unless the student is not accepted by the school, in which case \$100 will be withheld as a testing and processing fee.

**REENROLLMENT FEE - APPLIES TO RETURNING FAMILIES ONLY:** \$110 per student if paid by January 31, 2011; \$195 per student, if paid after January 31. (Does not apply to K4 - 3 Hours with VPK Certificate.) The reenrollment fee must accompany the reenrollment form. This fee is NOT REFUNDABLE.

**STUDENT FEE:** Per semester: K3 (All) - \$60; K4 Full Day - \$60 (does not apply to three hour VPK students with certificate); Grades K5-5 - \$95; Grades 6-8 - \$145; Grades 9-12 - \$175. This fee covers yearbook (if Student Fee is paid for both semesters), textbook rental, consumable materials, spring testing services and mandatory student insurance. The fee is due each semester and will be charged to your account on July 1, 2011 and January 1, 2012. Student fees are not prorated for early withdrawals.

**COMMENCEMENT FEE:** High School Graduation - \$120; K5 Kindergarten - \$35. The commencement fee will be charged to your account on the March statement.

**MIDDLE SCHOOL/HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FEES:** \$60 per player per sport (Middle School); \$85 per player per sport (High School); Exception: tackle football is \$160 per player, both Middle School and High School. These fees help defray the cost of athletic program staffing, referees, equipment and insurance. Athletic fees will be charged to your account as applicable.

**MISCELLANEOUS MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL FEES:** Curriculum differs from student to student. Most fees associated with activities and classes that pertain to all students are included in the STUDENT FEE. Other fees, such as Band Fee, Choir Fee, Lab Fee, Art Fee, SAT Prep Fee, and fees associated with AP or Honors classes are charged as incurred.

Bus service is available by contract for the entire school year only. The school reserves the right to raise fees or terminate bus service if the number of riders is not sufficient to cover actual costs. Bus fees are added to your account and are payable in SEVEN payments beginning on September 1, 2011 with the final payment on March 1, 2012.

The school reserves the right to limit the distance beyond the stated boundaries. A specific number of designated stops will be established within each area. Every effort will be made to provide bus transportation from a convenient pick-up point with minimum time on the bus for all who desire it.

**EXTENDED DAY:** An optional Extended School Program provides supervised care for BRCS students in K3 through Grade 5 before and after school. You may enroll your child on an annual basis by contract, in which case you will be billed monthly. You may also use this service occasionally on a cash basis. Details and rates are available in a separate brochure.

The regulations and requirements, tuition and fees and contents of the school's instructional program are subject to change with 30 days notice at the discretion of the BRCS School Board.
