## WHOLE CHILD EDUCATION Students grow academically, spiritually,

BRCS partners with families to uphold the highest standards and supports parental efforts to raise Christ-centered, well-rounded scholars.

**MISSION TRIPS** High school students don't just learn about faith, they live it out. Over four years, they take part in meaningful mission trips, powerful spiritual retreats, and hands-on service projects that make a real difference in the community. These experiences broaden their perspective, help them grow stronger in their faith, and shape their character.

**ADMISSIONS** BRCS seeks applicants who demonstrate strong academic ability, have a family commitment to their church, and desire to become part of the BRCS community. Our admissions team considers a candidate's previous school record, conduct, teachers' recommendations, and admission test results. Based on the demographics as reported to Data and Analysis of School Leadership: the background for our students is African American/Black 8%, Asian American 1%, Caucasian 44%, Latino-Hispanic 24%, multiracial 6%, and other 18%

**SECURITY** BRCS provides full-time security officers with extensive prior law enforcement experience and first responder training. Security also includes controlled visitor access through the Raptor Security national database, cameras, a perimeter fence on the east campus, locked classrooms, exterior doors, and gates. Staff, faculty, and parents who volunteer regularly are fingerprinted and background checks are conducted.

**BLAZER ATHLETIC PROGRAM** The Blazer Athletic Program provides student-athletes opportunities to develop and use their God-given abilities for His glory. Coaches challenge athletes to strive for excellence in their sport and personal lives. Many BRCS athletes have continued their academic careers as collegiate athletes.

**FINE ARTS PROGRAM** Our Fine Arts Program empowers high school students to use their talents to honor and serve God with creativity, passion, and excellence. From drama and music to visual arts and production engineering, students refine their skills in a variety of artistic disciplines. **BRCS is on a semester schedule** with one credit equal to 36 weeks of instruction delivered in 45-minute daily periods.

**The high school offers three diplomas:** Standard, College Preparatory, and Advanced.

The Advanced Diploma requires credits in a minimum of six honors level courses, Physics or AP®/Dual Enrollment Science, AP®/Two Dual Enrollment Math Courses, and AP®/Dual Enrollment English or AP®/Dual Enrollment Social Science, while maintaining a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.

## HONORS, AP®, AND DUAL ENROLLMENT
