LOWER SCHOOL ACADEMICS Lower School students build strong foundations in Bible, language arts, spelling, math, science, and social studies. Including mastering math facts and cursive handwriting.

Weekly, students are provided enrichment that broadens their learning and inspires growth. In Spanish, students begin to develop language skills and an appreciation for other cultures. In Physical Education, they build strength, coordination, and teamwork. The Media Center uses a variety of resources to foster a love for reading and teaches students how to research.
