ACADEMICS Middle school students are challenged through core curriculum, STEAM, world languages, technology, chapel, and competitive academics. Our Middle School math program offers high school-level math beginning in seventh grade for students who meet the set criteria.

ATHLETICS The school's athletic programs are committed to providing student athletes with experiences that will inspire them to fully develop their God-given gifts for His glory. Competitive interscholastic sports begin in fifth grade. With over ten different sports available, students can explore their interests in various areas. The program emphasizes sportsmanship, discipline, and teamwork, preparing students to succeed both on and off the field.

FINE ARTS The fine arts program offers a rich and diverse range of opportunities, designed to inspire creativity. Middle school students are able to participate in choir, band, art, praise and worship, theatre, advanced theatre, and Junior Thespians.
