

First Grade Supply List

Listed below are some of the supplies that first grade students will be responsible for having at school. Most supplies can be purchased at stores such as Office Depot, Office Max, Staples, Wal-Mart, Target, K-Mart, etc.

>Please be careful to adhere to the size requirements of materials (number of crayons, etc.)

1. Bible - SPECIFICALLY NIV Adventure Bible, ISBN 978-0-310-72747-7
2. Crayons (24 count ONLY!)
3. Broad tip markers (no larger than 10 count)
4. Watercolor paint set (8 colors)
5. 1 box colored pencils (no larger than 12 count)
6. 3 glue sticks (We may need more in January.)
7. 1 bottle Elmer's glue
8. 2 pink or white bar erasers
9. 1 pair pointed scissors
10. 2 boxes **sharpened** pencils; we may need more in January.
11. 1 can **Playdoh** only (any color)
12. 2 **yellow** highlighters
13. 1 school supply box for pencils and erasers (approximately 6"x9")
14. 3 folders that stand when opened; they generally have a shiny picture on the outside. Two will stand as "offices" for tests and one will serve as a homework folder. (Please, **NO PLASTIC FOLDERS!** They do not stand up like we need them to!)
15. 1 box wipes that can be used for cleaning hands. (We may need 1 more in January.)
16. 1 box Ziploc quart size plastic bags
17. 1 box of Kleenex
18. 1 box of bandages
19. Headphones



Each child should have a backpack that will be brought to school each day. These do not need to be large as children have only 2 books and a folder to go back and forth from home to school. Please, no bags with wheels.
