One-half of the Student Fee is earned upon the first day of the first semester. The second half is earned on the first day of the second semester. Student Fees are payable according to the Payment Plan selected. This fee covers yearbook (if annual Student Fee is paid in full), textbook rental, consumable materials, Middle/High School home room activity fee, Maps testing, and mandatory student insurance. **Student fees are not pro-rated for early withdrawals.** Yearbook is available to VPK students with certificate for \$75.00.

SECURITY FEE: \$220 per student (11 payments May-Mar -\$20), (Does not apply to K4- 3 Hours with VPK Certificate.) One-half of the Security Fee is earned upon the first day the first semester. The second half is earned on the first day of the second semester. Security fees are payable according to the Payment Plan selected. **Security fees are not pro-rated for early withdrawals.** The security fee is waived after the second child.

TECHNOLOGY FEE: (Students Grades K5-12) -\$100 per student **non-refundable** fee due with the first tuition payment.

ONLINE ENROLLMENT/REENROLLMENT FEE- NON-REFUNDABLE – RETURNING STUDENTS: \$200 per student if paid by February 1, 2023; \$400 per student thereafter, payable during enrollment/reenrollment. (Does not apply to K4 - 3 Hours with VPK Certificate.) Reenrollment fee is waived after the third child.

NEW STUDENTS ONLY: NON-REFUNDABLE ONLINE APPLICATION FEE - \$100 per student (does not apply to K4 - 3 Hours with VPK Certificate) payable at the time the application is submitted. After acceptance, a **NON-REFUNDABLE ONLINE ENROLLMENT FEE** of \$400 is due when submitted.

TUITION AND FEE PAYMENT PLANS: Select a payment plan during the online enrollment/reenrollment process. Three options are available for payment of tuition and fees from a bank account or from your credit card:

Option 1-ONE PAYMENT: Pay full year tuition, technology fee, student fee, security fee, and all contracted services (Extended School Contract and K4 Enrichment Hour) in a single payment. Payment is drafted from your bank account or credit card by FACTS on May 3rd or May 17th at your option. If a credit card is used, a 2.95% Service Fee will be charged. A 3% discount (on the tuition portion only) applies (see PRE-PAYMENT DISCOUNT, below). If contracted services are subsequently added, charges are due and payable prior to commencement of services. Incidental charges are billed separately.

Option 2 – TWO PAYMENTS: Pay full year tuition, student fee, security fee, and all contracted services in two equal payments. Technology Fee is due in the first payment. Payments are drafted from your bank account or credit card by FACTS in May and December on the 3rd or the 17th at your option. If a credit card is used, a 2.95% Service Fee will be charged. Incidental charges are billed separately.

Option 3 –11 MONTHLY PAYMENTS: Pay full year tuition, student fee, security fee, and all contracted services on a monthly payment schedule. Technology Fee is due in the first payment. Tuition, student fees, and security fees will be paid over 11 months (May 2023-March 2024). Payments for other contracted services are paid during the service period (typically September 2023-March 2024). If you subscribe to contracted services, you will be notified in advance of changes in your monthly payment amount. Payments are drafted from your bank account or from your credit card by FACTS on the 3rd or 17th of each month at your option. If you use a credit card, a 2.95% Service Fee will be charged. Incidental charges are billed separately.

Administrative Fees - For all items returned NSF, a \$30 fee will be assessed by FACTS. A late fee of 1.5% per month will be assessed for bank drafts that are unsuccessful after two attempts.

Withdrawal Fee: When a student voluntarily withdraws from the school for any reason, tuition is pro-rated based on the number of school days the student was enrolled. *An early withdrawal fee of 1/11 is charged after May 31st and 2/11's after June 30th (the equivalent of one and two monthly payments based on annual tuition).*

INCIDENTAL CHARGES, such as athletic fees, commencement fees, fine arts fees, daily Extended School services, etc. will be posted to FACTS and accessible to you on Family Portal. A billing statement will be transmitted to you on the 18th of each month via the method you select detailing the incidental charges incurred during the previous month. Your bank account will be drafted for these charges on the 1st of the following month. Credit card payments have a 2.95% Service Fee applied. **You MUST always maintain a valid automatic method of payment.**

Administrative Fees - For all items returned NSF, a \$30 fee will be assessed by FACTS. If payment is not remitted within 10 days of the return, a late fee of 1.5% per month will be charged for any balance over \$100.

PRE-PAYMENT DISCOUNT: For re-enrolling families, *a net tuition* (equal to published tuition less multiple child discount) discount of 3% will be applied when Payment Option 1 (above) is selected. **(Pre-payment discount is not available to families receiving discounts, BRCS financial aid, or any type of scholarship).** For newly enrolling families to qualify for a pre-payment discount, the account must be paid by May 17, 2023. Pre-payment discount is available for students attending for the full school year.

MULTIPLE CHILD DISCOUNT: (Applies to tuition only; K3 and K4 tuitions are not eligible). For families who enroll more than one child, tuition discounts are applied as follows: first child (highest grade level) - no discount; second child (second highest grade level) - 5% discount; third child - 10% discount, fourth child and additional children -15%.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE: Applications for financial aid are available at FACTS Family Portal after January 2, 2023. Returning students should apply for financial assistance *no later than April 15, 2023*. **You are responsible for regular payments of FULL TUITION prior to receiving a financial aid award.** Your account will be adjusted if/when aid is awarded.

COMMENCEMENT FEE: High School Graduation - \$300; K5 Kindergarten - \$75. The commencement fee will be charged to your incidental billing account on the March 2024 statement.

ELEMENTARY/MIDDLE/HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC FEES -NON-REFUNDABLE: \$100/player per sport (Elementary), \$150/player per sport (Middle School), \$200/player per sport (High School); Exception: tackle football; \$200/player (Middle School), \$250/player (High School). These fees help defray the cost of athletic program staffing, referees, equipment, and insurance. Athletic fees will be charged to your incidental billing account as applicable.

MISCELLANEOUS MIDDLE SCHOOL AND HIGH SCHOOL FEES – NON-REFUNDABLE: Curriculum differs from student to student. Most fees associated with activities and classes that pertain to all students are included in the STUDENT FEE. Other fees, such as Band Fee, Choir Fee, Lab Fee, Art Fee, SAT Prep Fee, and fees associated with AP or Honors classes are charged as incurred.

EXTENDED SCHOOL: An optional Extended School Program provides supervision for BRCS students in K3 through Grade 5 after school (3:15-5:30 p.m.). You may use this service occasionally or enroll your child on an annual basis by contract at a discount. Details and rates are available in a separate brochure. Extended school supervision for Middle School students (3:15-5:30 p.m.) and High School students (4:15-5:30 p.m.) is *required if on campus when not participating in a school sponsored activity*, available at \$9.00 per day. Annual contracts for K3 through 5 will be added to your tuition and fees payment plan beginning with the September 2023 payment and continuing through the March 2024 payment. Occasional use will be charged to your incidental billing account.

ADDENDUM FOR HOME-SCHOOL STUDENTS

All home-school students must apply or re-enroll on-line.

HIGH SCHOOL ACADEMIC OFFERINGS FOR HOME-SCHOOL STUDENTS: High School courses and activities are offered to home-school students on a space available basis. High School tuition is \$1,675 per semester per half-credit class. The **Non-refundable** Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee is \$400. Home-school students wishing to graduate from Boca Raton Christian School are required to enroll as *full-time students for their senior year*. Students may purchase a yearbook for \$75. If a student is issued a Chromebook, it must be returned at the end of the semester. A fine will be charged for any damages.

ATHLETICS OFFERINGS FOR HOME-SCHOOL STUDENTS: All students involved in home-school athletics will pay an Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee of \$600, which includes participation in one sport. Fees for participation in additional sports are \$200 per sport.

HIGH SCHOOL FINE ARTS OFFERINGS FOR HOME-SCHOOL STUDENTS: Students in grades 9 or above are welcome to try out for a supporting role in the high school spring musical. An Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee of \$600 will be charged for the first Fine Arts elective. If students elect to participate and space is available in other fine arts programs, for each additional program, the fee is \$200. Other fees associated with the musical or other programs the student elects to participate in are also due and payable as assessed. (ex. Musical fees for costumes, competition fees etc.)

PAYMENT: **All home school fees are payable in advance.** Tuition must be paid in full before a student may attend class. Athletic Fees must be paid in full for any sport before a student may participate in that sport (including practices). Fine Arts Fees must be paid in full prior to try out, and/or participation.

HOME SCHOOL FEE REFUND POLICY:

Athletics Offerings: If a home-school student tries out and is not selected for a FIRST sport, \$250 of the Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee will be refunded. If a home-school student tries out and is not selected for an ADDITIONAL sport, the \$200 Participation Fee for that sport will be refunded in full.

Fine Arts Offering (Spring Musical): If a home-school student tries out and is not selected for a supporting role in the Spring Musical, \$250 of the Enrollment/Reenrollment Fee will be refunded.
