THREE GRADE LEVELS HIGHER* Students perform as much as three grades higher than the national average. Eighth grade students perform beyond 11th grade level, first grade students perform one grade level higher, grades 2-4 perform over their grade levels, fifth grade students perform almost two grades higher, and by seventh grade students perform almost three grades higher.

WHOLE CHILD EDUCATION Students grow academically, spiritually, emotionally, and socially at BRCS. Regardless of pandemics, world disorder, politics or societal opposition to Biblical Truths, BRCS persists in delivering a superior, secure, challenging, and well-rounded experience to prepare students for high school, college, and career.

BIBLICAL WORLDVIEW Students are encouraged to know, love, and serve Jesus Christ. Biblical principles are integrated into the curriculum, exemplified in administration, faculty, and staff, demonstrated through service projects, practiced in weekly chapel, and honed during Spiritual Emphasis activities. Traditional values, particularly around topics that defy Biblical principles are protected, upheld, and enforced through steadfast guidelines and actions. Families move their children from other private schools to BRCS for this reason.

SECURITY BRCS employs full-time security staff with prior law enforcement experience and first responder training. Doors, gates, windows, and classrooms are locked and security cameras installed. Badges or driver's license screening are required. BRCS faculty, staff, and parents who volunteer regularly are fingerprinted.

COUNSELING SERVICES* *The counseling staff supports students in navigating academic, social-emotional, career, and personal development goals, utilizing God's Word and the best counseling practices. All school counselors have a master's degree or higher.*

PARENTS ARE PARTNERS Parents and family members are encouraged to volunteer and connect with other families through opportunities such as Parents in Prayer and volunteering opportunities in homerooms, for the annual auction, in athletics, for the Science Fair, and Serve-a-thon.

ELEMENTARY Students master core academic concepts and enrichment activities such as music, art, physical education, Spanish, STEAM (Science, Tech, Engineering, Art, Math). Students compete in the Science Fair, math and spelling competitions, Bible Drills, and enjoy competitive athletics (Grades 4 & 5 only). Academically Talented in grades 2-5 explore STEAM concepts.

MIDDLE SCHOOL 6-8 grade students are challenged through core curriculum and STEAM, world languages, technology, physical education, music, art, drama, chapel, etiquette, and competitive interscholastic athletics. Eighth grade students participate in career exploration and etiquette. Middle school students compete in the Science Fair and academic competitions, English Honors courses and eighth grade students can enroll in high school-level math classes.

STEAM MAKERSPACE Students collaborate, explore, and engage in STEAM using their creativity, inventiveness, and innovation in a hands-on, interactive, high-tech experience through 3D digital printers, robots, coding, gaming, and photography/videography.

ADMISSIONS Family commitment to Christian education along with the student's academic history, conduct, and performance on standardized achievement tests is considered for admission.
